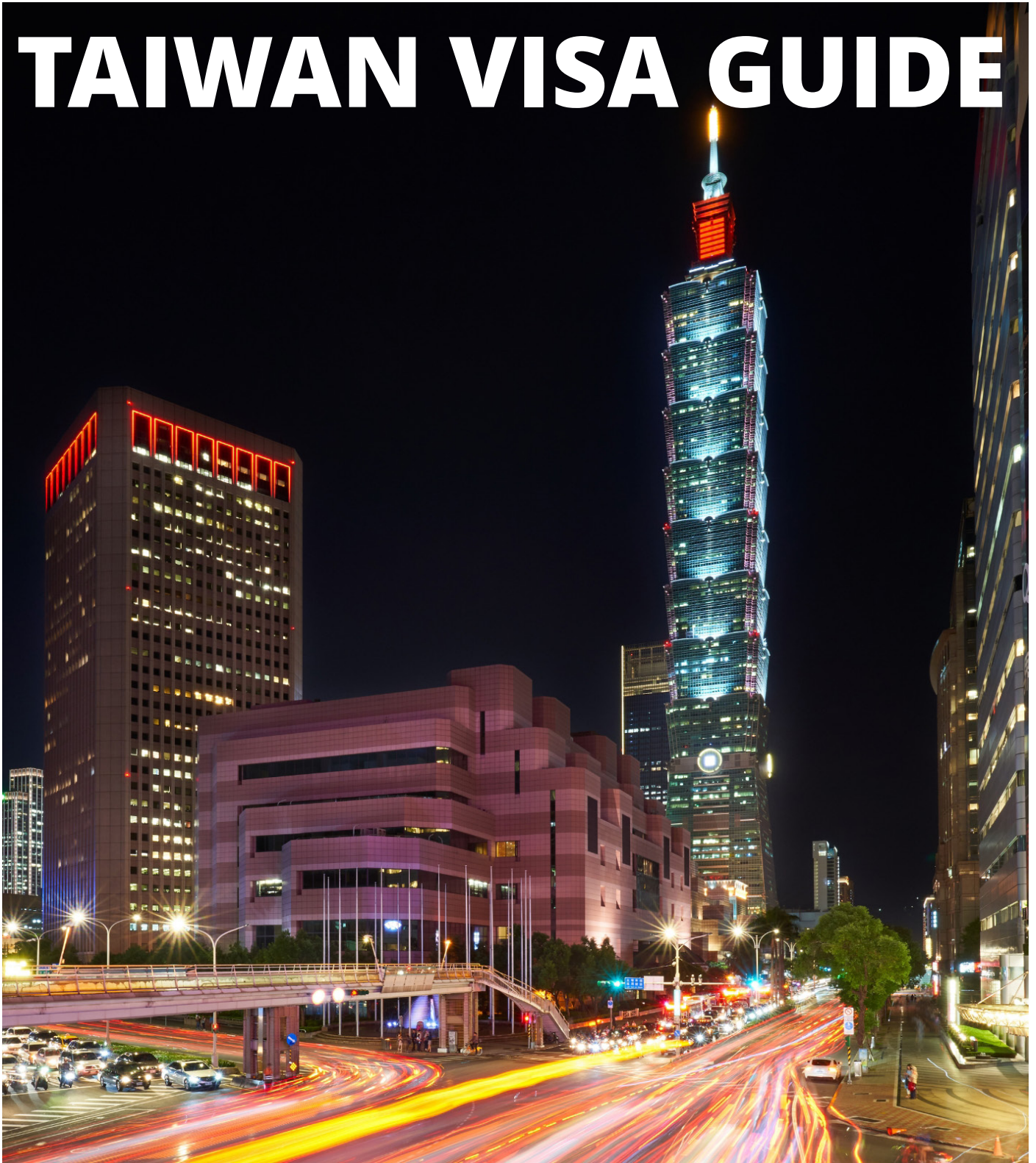


# TAIWAN VISA GUIDE

Kindly double-check the current situation beforehand and keep yourself updated.



## GOOD TO KNOW:

There is no “Student Visa” in Taiwan. Instead, Taiwan offers 2 types of Visas for foreign students:

- Visitor Visa
- Resident Visa

You should apply for a visitor visa if you stay less than 6 months. If your program is longer than 6 months, you will need to apply for a resident visa.

The Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) is an ID card for students who hold a Resident Visa. If you arrived Taiwan with a Resident Visa, you would need to apply for the ARC from the National Immigration Agency within 15 days of your arrival.

If you arrive in Taiwan with a Visitor Visa but plan to stay in Taiwan over 6 months, you will need to switch your visa to a Resident Visa [please refer to “Visa for foreign students (degree)”], and then apply for the ARC from the National Immigration Agency.

Requirements	Description
<b>Application Form</b>	Fill out the application form online and print it out
<b>Passport(Original &amp; Photocopy)</b>	Valid for 6 months with blank pages
<b>2 passport-size photos</b>	Color photos with a white background taken within 6 months
<b>Certificate of Admission (Original &amp; Photocopy)</b>	Admission Letter or record of enrollment and registration sent by your university or college
<b>Record of Enrollment of the Overseas school (Original &amp; Photocopy)</b>	Issued by the school where you come from.
